Assessment Determination

If any species is categorised as Endangered or Critically Endangered on IUCN's Red List, or if it appears in the CITES appendices, it cannot be approved for use as Marin trust raw material. Pouting (*Trisopterus luscus*) has been categorised by the IUCN as Least Concern, and it does not appear in the CITES appendices. Therefore, *Trisopterus luscus* is eligible for approval for use as Marin trust by-product raw material.

There are no biomass-based reference points established for pouting in ICES Division 7a, and the stock does not appear to be subjected to stock assessment. For this reason, it was assessed under Category D.

Pouting was assigned a Productivity score of 1.29 and a Susceptibility score of 2.5, leading to an outcome of Pass on Table D3.

Therefore, pouting (*Trisopterus luscus*) in ICES Division 7a is **APPROVED** for the production of fishmeal and fish oil under the current MarinTrust v2.3 by-products.

Fishery Assessment Peer Review Comments

The assessor correctly classified pouting (*Trisopterus luscus*) in ICES Division 7.a as Category D, the stock is not managed.

The assessor correctly assigned attribute scores under the PSA and correctly calculated the average scores for Productivity and Susceptibility, respectively. The stock passes per Table D3.

Pouting (*Trisopterus luscus*) in ICES Division 7.a passes Category D and therefore should be approved under the MarinTrust Standard v.2.3

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CATEGORY D SPECIES

Category D species are those which are not subject to a species-specific management regime. In the case of mixed trawl fisheries, Category D species may make up the majority of landings. The comparative lack of scientific information on the status of the population of the species means that a risk-assessment style approach must be taken.
